



Marfan Memorial Quilt Project

The Marfan Memorial Quilt was started to celebrate the lives of people we have lost to the Marfan syndrome and related disorders.

You may create a block to be included by following the following guidelines:

- Finished blocks should be 12” x 12”, PLUS a ½” seam allowance on all sides (a total of 13”x 13”). Blocks that are not the appropriate size will not be able to be included in the quilt.
- Please make sure to include the name of the person you are memorializing on the block.
- 100% cotton fabric works best for the base of your block, but you may embellish or decorate your block however you want.
- Do NOT “layer” the quilt. We only need the top block. We will combine your block with the other submissions and then add the batting and backing.
- Be creative! Use photographs copied or transferred onto fabric (check a local craft supply store), appliqués, fabric paints, lettering, buttons, etc. Incorporate their hobbies, interests, family, special quotes. Anything that helps you tell the story of your special person.
- Submit your completed block with a \$25 suggested donation to the NMF Quilt Project to the NMF, 22 Manhasset Avenue, Port Washington, NY 11050, Attention Quilt Project. Your donation will benefit the NMF Public Awareness efforts. For more information, please 800-8-MARFAN, extension 16.

Twelve individual blocks will be combined to make larger panels that will be displayed at Public Awareness events and future NMF conferences.
